```

Arguments

`file` path to a HTML file; can be missing
`theme, fontSize` options passed to [aceEditor](#)

Examples

```
# launch the Shiny app without file ####  
if(interactive()) html2R()  
  
# launch the Shiny app with a file ####  
if(interactive()){  
  html2R(system.file("example.html", package = "html2R"))  
}
```
